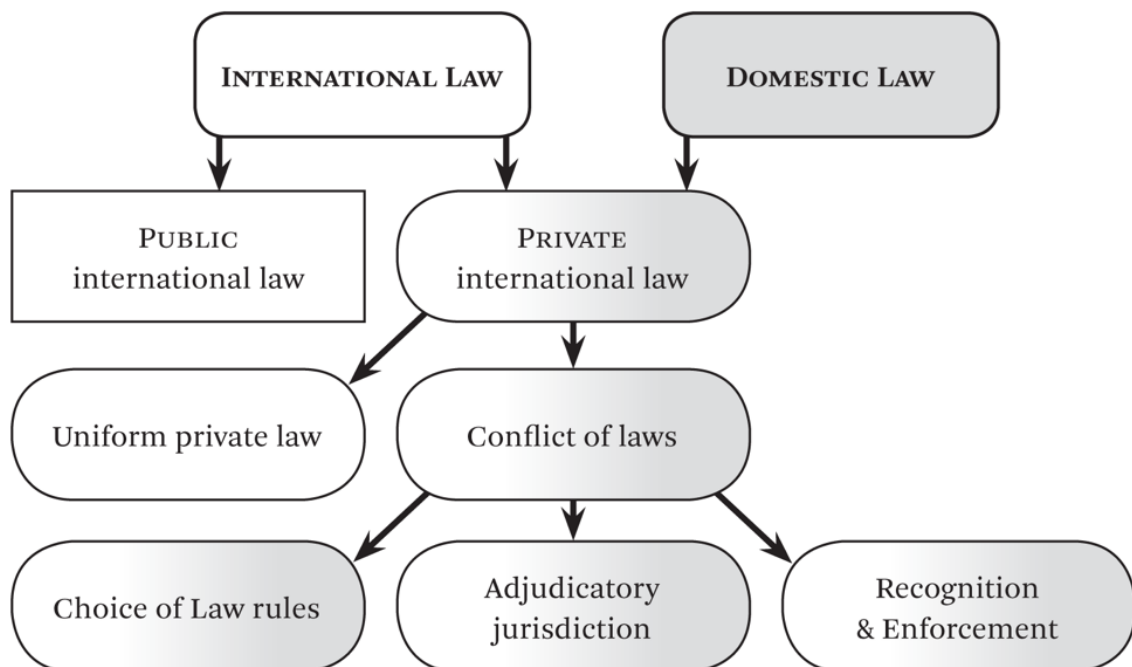

Europeanisation & Internationalisation of Law

- **justification:**
 - protection of peace among nations
 - protection of human rights
 - enhancement of economic development
 - augmentation of wealth of societies and citizens
 - protection of natural resources
- this cannot be achieved by nation states

- **What is the aim and content of the legal rule?**
 - states or private individuals
 - organisations and its institutions (institutional law)
 - rights and duties of private persons (substantive law)
 - field of law
 - determination of applicable law (choice of law/conflict of laws)

- **Which institution(s) is/are competent to apply, interpret and enforce the legal rule?**
 - in public int'l law absent
 - application of national court system
 - institutions of international organisations or the EU
